There were instances, when His Eminence also met with ALPS members and he assisted . to make a presentation to His Holiness Pope Francis when we organized a visit to Rome some years back. We have also had the pleasure to knock on his door at the Istituto Santa Marta near the Bernini Collonade, when purely by chance a group of ALPS members happened to be visiting the Vatican City whilst taking an excursion from a cruise liner.





All the members and friends of Ghaqda Ex-Studenti Liceo can vividly remember his soft spoken homilies whenever we invited him to join us for some special event, like a reunion, or celebrating Holy Mass at a quaint little chapel in Pwales hamlet. He simply loved to be with his Lyceum comrades. The last grand event that we are proud of, was the celebration of Holy Mass at St John's Co-Cathedral Valetta during March 2019 on the occasion of a 25th Anniversary Celebration from foundation date of ALPS. Always a great honor for us to have His Eminence with us and we all treasure some nice memories of his gentle jokes that he shared and narratives from his younger years at The Lyceum Malta.
