
lecturer will be announced at a future date.



No oil or gas is used to heat or air-condition the hotel, which relies on solar roof panels, geo thermal energy

In Memoriam



Soon after the last issue of ALPS News Letter, one of our council members George Grech passed on to Eternal Life after a short illness borne with Christian Fortitude. We are representing hereunder a eulogy prepared by our ALPS President and which has been published in the local newspapers too.

APPRECIATION -**GEORGE** GRECH 1935 - 2015

Mentioning George Grech would no doubt bring a thought of a 'LICEO' Headmaster who dedicated a good number of years to see the school excel in the secondary education for yound boys . George was very much successful to instill in the students under his care, a sense of sharing and of taking on responsibilities in life. Those same students are today's generation of family leaders, who now instill in their own children, the same valuable principles that had been passed on to them by the headmaster of their time at the Lyceum. They all yearn for those stupendous years that they had spent at the Lyceum under the care and wise guidance of a dedicated headmaster who wanted the school to rise to a



high standard. George Grech worked ever so hard to witness the start of a special event that is still very active till this very year. It is called MARATONA BIR-ROTI. As a matter of fact, this year 2015 happens to see the sixteenth edition of such a grand event. Over the years this event has been the source of fundraising which benefitted many good causes. Each year, George was instrumental and attended for all the meetings of Maratona Committee in charge of organizing such a wonderful initiative. Rain or shine he never failed to give his contribution in order to ensure that everything run smoothly. participation went even further by physically helping to man the cash point at the food and drinks bar during the maratona week-end.

Another milestone in George Grech's life was his initial assistance that he extended to Founder President Dr. Guido Saliba, who in 1994 had founded the Association of Lyceum Past Students (ALPS). It was the birth of a dynamic association of Ex-Alumni who never stop dreaming of their childhood and of the learning they have acquired from Liceo. George was a founder member

and his ongoing participation in such an association was duly rewarded in recognition for the great enthusiasm to gather as many as possible Lyceum Past Students from all walks fo life and of varying ages, to get together and to reminisce from the good old Lyceum days. Worth mentioning is the founder president's promise and the name of George Grech has in fact been entered into and, forms part of a revised ALPS statute, whereby, he is referred to with the wording Permanent Member "Ad Honorem" Over the past twenty years of ALPS George has occupied many different posts on council of administration. Up to December of last year, he was still sitting at the council table together with his fellow colleagues whilst attending for the monthly meetings.

George Grech is survived by his dear wife Mary Rose and his four children Catherine, Ivan, Roberta and Adrian and their spouses together with his nine grandchildren. Nannu George leaves a great void in the lives of his heirs but a great inheritance in their hearts with love and affection that nobody can take away from them. George would have been 80 years in July this year. He passed on to eternal life short of twenty days from the next edition of Martona Bir-Roti 2015. The Association of Lyceum Past Students (ALPS), salutes one of its stalwarts. May he now be remembered for all the good work that he carried out during his life and may his memory bring peace and happiness to all who have known him. Rest in Peace dear George - Amen.
