The year 2024 was the second year with a change in the administration of the Association of Lyceum Past Students. The new president was Mr. George Galea, replacing George Stagno Navara after 21 Years and new Segretary General Mark Darmanin replacing Alex Borg after 29 years. Both George SN remained as the immediate past president and Alex Borg remained as Assistant Segretary General. Unfortunately, Mr. David Abela Hon Treasurer has passed away in March 2023 and his position was taken also by Mr Alex Borg. The year 2024 was a special year for ALPS as was 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary since it was formed and operated all these years with endless activities and memories for members and their relatives and friends. Were also organized special event to commemorate this 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

The first monthly virtual council of administration meeting was held in January 2024 through TEAM link.
