

Holy mass at Pwales chapel at 16.30pm (H.E. The President of Malta will attend and meet with members/neighbors)


#### 8th December 2014

### **Cultural tour to Birgu** on the 4th October 2014

The date is getting closer for the A.L.P.S. cultural tour to Birgu. As already announced, we have planned an interesting morning tour. We all meet and park our cars near Couvre Port (just outside Birgu) and the tour leader chosen for this event will start at 9.15 sharp.

A short talk before we start our walk to the Inquisitor's Palace can explain the potential of this area and what we are about to explore. The visit to the Inquisitor's palace should last about an hour and we shall then be given a half hour free time to stop and have a coffee (not included) at any one of the nearby outlets. At 11.00 o'clock the tour continues with a walk to the Maritime Museum at the Waterfront.

There, we shall be given a full explanation by the tour guide about all the exhibits at the museum. This should take us up to around 12.30hrs including question time and the tour ends. We then proceed to "Bacino Café" where we shall have light lunch as detailed in the attached booking form. The price of the Birgu tour including the services of a guide and light-lunch only at mid-day, will be at €18.00 per person.

Please fill in and send your booking form with menu choice and pre-payment to secretary general Alex Borg by latest 2nd October to enable us to inform the caterers about the number of seating places to be prepared for the A.L.P.S. group. After lunch, we are doing our best to organize for the A.L.P.S. group on this tour, to hear holy mass at the nearby Oratorju of Birgu. More details can follow on the date of the tour itself, because this all depend on the church authorities granting permission for such celebration and getting a priest to say Holy Mass.

### The Valletta Cultural Tour on the 29th November 2014

To continue to enrich the 20th anniversary celebrations this year, we shall be organizing for you, another cultural tour to Valletta on the 29th November 2014. We all meet at 09.15am outside St John's Co-Cathedral at side door in Republic Street (opposite the LAW COURTS). The two appointed tour-guides will split the number of participants in groups of 30 each and will start at exactly 09.30am sharp. The guided tour explanations inside the cathedral take approximately one and a half hours. Free time shall be given around 11.00hrs. The group will then proceed at 11.30 on foot to The Grand Master's Palace Valletta for the continuation of the morning Valletta visit. Our quides will again take the separate groups to explain the history and the riches of such magnificent Palace. This guided tour should last up to approximately 12.45hrs. Then, we can walk up Republic Street and go to The Caravaggio Restaurant St. John's square for a light lunch. For those of you who would like to join us, a light lunch at Caravaggio Restaurant (menu choice shown on application form) is being organized. The price of the tour with mid-day lunch only, shall




