The long awaited visit to Rome for a General Audience with His Holiness Pope Francis, is getting nearer. The Association of Lyceum Past Students, is celebrating its 20th anniversary this year and we thought, that the best event in the history of A.L.P.S., can not be better than a trip to the Vatican. Hereunder, you will find details of a proposed three nights stay at a hotel close-by to Piazza San Pietro. If it has been your dream to make this trip a memory of a lifetime, now is the time for you to decide and place your airplane/hotel bookings through SMS Mondial, who have been entrusted with all reservations on behalf of A.L.P.S. members and friends.

GENERAL AUDIENCE AT THE VATICAN ON THE 5TH NOVEMBER 2014., WITH RESERVED SEATING IN PIAZZA SAN PIETRO for THE A.L.P.S. GROUP (we have been informed that we should be seated close to the front)

We are now pleased to advise you that through SMS Mondial, we have finalized packages @ €349 PP. In triple rooms, €359 PP in double rooms and for single person it will cost €381. Prices shall be inclusive of air tickets to and from Roma, airport taxes, coach transfers from Rome airport and back, B & B accommodation at Hotel Pacific close to Piazza San Pietro. We also have the services of an SMS tour leader for the period 4th November to 7th November 2014. This gives us a good chance to go around Rome and enjoy the many beautiful sights that this city has to offer. Please note that SMS Mondial shall be solely responsible for all the bookings. A.L.P.S. Is in no way involved nor is it responsible for any loss or damage that may be incurred before / during or after such a tour to Rome. Please find the PNR as follows:

Leaving on the 4th November 2014 Flight KM 612H MLAFCO 08.30/ 10.00hrs (AM) Returning on the 7th November 2014 Flight KM 613H FCOMLA 11.00/12.25hrs (AM)

Because of a limited number of airline tickets and hotel rooms, we recommend that you approach at earliest SMS Mondial of 311 Republic Street Valletta and pay a deposit of €150 per person (full balance becomes payable to SMS Mondial at 1st week of Oct 2014). You may ask for M/s Ruth Fero' at the travel office and she will take all the bookings (Tel: 2277 6016) This ensures seating on the plane for a Papal Audience on the 5th Nov 14. Plane tickets and hotel rooms are on first come first serve basis. *Please take the passports with you when paying the deposit.*

We shall be looking forward to see many of you joining us on this memorable tour.
